A Proper Attitude

Proper Attire

Clothing

Keep it modest!

*Tank tops need > 2 inch straps

*Shorts need to reach the ends of your fingertips

Casual clothes - think T-Shirts, Running shorts, tennis shoes, etc. Remember, it's camp! Be comfortable.

Swimwear

Keep it modest!

*Ladies, please pack a one-piece swimsuit or a dark-colored tshirt to wear over your 2 piece.

*Guys, please pack an appropriate swimsuit. No speedos. Shorts must reach the ends of your fingertips.

Shoes

Shoes that you don't mind getting wet for recreation

Nicer shoes for worship.

Proper Personal Items

- *Towels and washcloth.
- *Toiletries: Make-up is fine.
- *Toothbrush AND toothpaste.
- *Shampoo, hairbrush, and/or comb.
- *Deodorant is a must!!!
- *Sun block AND insect repellent.
- *Flashlight with working batteries. (optional)
- *YOUR BIBLE and a pen or pencil. (Paper is provided.)
- *Bedding (twin bunk beds) or sleeping bag and pillow.
- *Lawn chair for use at the pool. (optional)

Money

\$\$ is not necessary, but the gift shop and snack shop will be open for you to buy drinks, candy, ice cream, etc. You are responsible for keeping up with your own money.

WHAT TO LEAVE AT HOME

Cell Phones / Electronics that distract and isolate you from others while you're at camp.
